**CCSTA Endowment Fund Tuition Assistance Program – Application Process and Forms**

The vision of the Canadian Catholic School Trustees' Association (CCSTA) is to promote and protect the right to Catholic education in Canada. In alignment with this vision, CCSTA has established an Endowment Fund (Charitable Foundation) to assist elementary and secondary students with tuition costs at Canadian Catholic schools that receive limited or no government funding.

**Application Process**

Applications must be submitted by the school principal on behalf of the students. Each application should include **one to two paragraphs per family**, outlining:

- Reasons for applying
- Any special circumstances
- Involvement in school or parish activities
- Evidence of faith commitment

To maintain confidentiality, refer to families as "Family A," "Family B," etc. All student-specific information must be kept on file at the school.

The principal is responsible for completing both of the following CCSTA Endowment Fund Google Forms:

Each school may submit applications for **up to five families** per year.

**Key Dates and Funding Details**

- **Application Deadline:** March 30
- **Notification of Decisions:** By June 30
- **Disbursement of Funds:** September (after confirmation that students have returned to school)

Funding is awarded for **one academic year**. Families may reapply for assistance in future years.

If a student does not return in September and the school has received funding for multiple students, the school may reallocate the unused funds to other eligible students listed in the original application.
